



Brandenburg is home to a variety of rare animals, including white-tailed eagles, ospreys, beavers, and kingfishers, and it also provides ideal habitats for white storks and cranes.

Our multi-day-tours present the biosphere reserves Schorfheide Chorin (~ 65 km from Berlin) and Elbe-Brandenburg River Landscape (~ 150 km), as well as the High Fläming Nature Park (~ 75 km).

The visitor centres are the gateways to the various large conservation areas. Not only are they ideal starting points for walks, cycling tours, and boat trips in Brandenburg, they are also fun places for recreation and education.


